Removing a 400D Stationery Cabinet Door Lock

1) Using a Flat blade screwdriver prise off the 2 chrome plated buttons (retain) and remove lock rods.



2) While holding the door and pressing firmly to push the lock out of the door, use a screw driver to press down the plastic tabs found on the top and underside for the lock. When this is done firmly press the tab on the back of the lock to disengage the lock from the door.

3) The Lock can now be removed from the door.



4) Assembly is the reverse of this procedure.
